Topics this term will include:

We will be using the theme of 'Memory Box' as our focus for the first half term and using this to inspire our reading and topic work, including looking back at how we have changed, comparing ourselves now to when we were babies. We are looking at toys from the past and comparing them to the toys that we have now. We will be making a special memory box to keep everything we do. If you have a spare shoe box please send it in with your child.

In Science we are learning about different materials, this week we learnt to describe different materials and we worked together with a partner to sort materials.


We will be writing labels, lists and captions and simple stories with familiar topics in English. In Maths we are concentrating on number bonds and simple addition and subtraction.

In PE we will be learning how to create dances linked to stories and working on passing and accuracy of throwing in games. In computing we have started to become more aware of online safety and how to protect ourselves when using technology both at home and in school.

In PHSE we are following the Jigsaw program thinking about I like being me. In Year One we have spent time talking about and writing our class rules for learning and playing.

English Learning:

- Finger spaces between words.
- Using capital letters.
- Using punctuation to end a sentence.
- Writing sentences that make sense.
- Learning about nouns and plurals.



Maths Learning:

- Writing the numbers the correct way around 0-10.
- Counting on and back accurately up to 30.
- Read the number words 0-10 e.g. nought, six nine.



What you can do to help your child:

- *Talk to your child each day about their learning in school.*
- *Say aloud number bonds.*
- *Listen to your child read.*
