

## Sports Premium Funding at Holdbrook Primary School:

### **Background:**

The Government has been providing additional funding of £450 million over 3 years from 2013/14 to 2015/16. The funding is being provided for sports and physical education with the aim of improving the quality of P.E and sports activities provided by schools. The funding is being jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport and is being given directly to the schools.

This money is ring-fenced and can only be spent on P.E and sport within school. This covers both lessons within school and extra-curricular activities and clubs after school.

### **Allocation:**

Holdbrook Primary has £8783 to spend in this current year (2014/15).

### **How will we be spending the Sports Premium funding:**

At Holdbrook Primary we believe in providing a well-rounded P.E curriculum for all children, covering a range of different sports, skills and activities. We also believe it is important for children to participate in extra-curricular activities and we are expanding the sports that we provide. Not only to children who regularly play sport, but also for others, who might not actively take part in sports normally.

We will be spending the funding in the following ways.

- We will be investing in our P.E curriculum, so that the curriculum is up to date and in line with the new National Curriculum that came into effect this year.
- We are continuing our membership of Pathways Plus and the Waltham Cross & District Primary Schools Sports Association
- We will be starting up new extra-curricular clubs for children, such as netball, which has already started.
- Investing in new equipment or upgrading older equipment, so that the children have access to good quality equipment.
